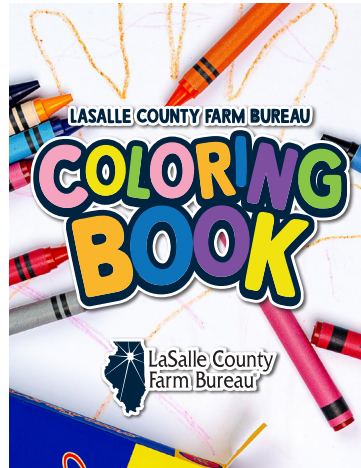


ELF ON THE SHELF

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APPLE CHAIN ACTIVITY

Materials:

- 2 red paper plates or white plates to be colored
- Crayons
- Glue
- Scissors
- Yarn
- Tap
- Stapler
- Hole punch
- Apple Chain templates (provided)

Instructions:

- Color & cut out each of the templates provided (seed, tree, blossom, bee, apple, leaf, stem)
- Punch a hole on each side of templates. The seed only gets one hole punch.
- Glue or staple 2 red paper plates together around 2/3 of the edge. Leave the other 1/3 open.
- Take a piece of yarn to the inside of the paper plates and extend the yarn out of the opening.
- Glue the stem and leaf to the red paper plates to make it look like an apple.
- Tie the little apple template to the yarn coming out of the apple. Tie the bee to the little apple. Tie the blossom to the hole. Tie the tree to the blossom. Tie the seed to the tree. All forming a chain.
- Tuck the chained templates into the apple. Starting with the seed, slowly pull shapes out of the apple to tell the story of how apples grow.
