DAIRY COW PONY BEAD KEY CHAIN

ITEMS NEEDED:

1. Tape (to help hold the key ring down while working on project)
2. Key Ring
3. 23 Inches of craft string
4. Pony Beads
 - a. 2 light pinks
 - b. 6 blacks
 - c. 12 white

STEPS

1. Take your string and fold in half to put the key-ring through the folded end and then stick the two ends through the loop.
2. String 3 white beads onto the right string.
3. Take the left string and send it through the beads in the opposite direction. Pull tight.
4. Put 2 black beads on the right string. Loop the same string back through the first black bead closet to the white bead, Skipping the one black bead closet to the end of the string. (**DO NOT** go through the white bead)
5. Repeat step 4 on the left side.
6. Put 4 white beads on the right string and repeat steps 2 and 3.
7. Continue pattern until finished.
8. Tie knot and cut extra string off.
