


## LADY BUG PONY BEAD ACTIVITY

## **ITEMS NEEDED:**

- 1. Tape (to help hold the key ring down while working on project)
- 2. Key Ring
- 3. 46 inches of craft string
- 4. Pony Beads: 38 red, 20 black

## **STEPS**

- 1. Take your string and fold in half to put the key ring through the folded end and then stick the 2 ends through the loop.
- 2. String 3 black beads onto the right string.
- **3.** Take the left string and send it through the beads in the opposite directions. Pull tight.
- **4.** Put 4 black beads on the right string and repeat steps 2 & 3.
- 5. Continue pattern until finished.
- 6. Tie knot and cut extra string off.
