



LaSalle County Farm Bureau understands the importance of proper training when it comes to fire and rescue. Because agriculture is one of the largest industries in LaSalle County, LaSalle County Farm Bureau Board of Directors has decided to offer ten \$200 grants to fire departments that participate in an agriculture training program in the year 2023. The trainings must be held by a certified trainer or the Illinois Fire Service Institute. Examples of approved agricultural courses include, but are not limited to, agriculture rescue techniques, anhydrous ammonia emergencies, fires on the farm, grain bin rescue awareness/operations, and large animal rescue awareness operations.

To qualify for this grant the Fire Department must meet the following requirements:

1. Be located in LaSalle County Illinois
2. Participate in an Agriculture related training hosted by Illinois Fire Service Institute or approved by the IFSI.
3. Complete the application included in this letter, additional copies of the application can be found at www.lcfb.org.
4. Return the completed application along with a flyer of the training to the Farm Bureau office six weeks before the date of training.

Once the board of directors reviews the application, you will be notified of your application status.

After proof of training completion is submitted to the LaSalle County Farm Bureau office, a check will be written and mailed to the fire department.
