



## CORN KEY CHAIN

### ITEMS NEEDED:

1. Tape *(to help hold the key ring down while working on project)*
2. Key Ring
3. 23 Inches of craft string
4. Pony Beads
  - a. 26 yellow
  - b. 30 green

### STEPS

1. Take your string and fold in half to put the key-ring through the folded end and then stick the two ends through the loop.
2. String two yellow beads onto one string.
3. Take the other string and send it through the beads in the opposite direction and pull tight.
4. Continue using the steps 2 & 3 following the pattern shown in picture.
5. Once the pattern is complete take the ends of the string and double knot them. Trim off the extra string and you are finished!
