



PUMPKIN PONY BEAD ACTIVITY

ITEMS NEEDED:

1. Tape (to help hold the key ring down while working on project)
2. Key Ring
3. 2 yards (72 inches) of craft string
4. Pony Beads
 - a. 3 green
 - b. 8 black
 - c. 51 orange

STEPS

1. Take your string and fold in half to put the key-ring through the folded end and then stick the two ends through the loop.
2. String 1 green bead onto the right string.
3. Take the left string and send it through the bead in the opposite direction. Pull tight.
4. String 2 green beads on the right string and repeat step 3.
5. Continue using the steps 2 & 3 following the pattern shown in the picture.
6. Tie knot and cut extra string off.
